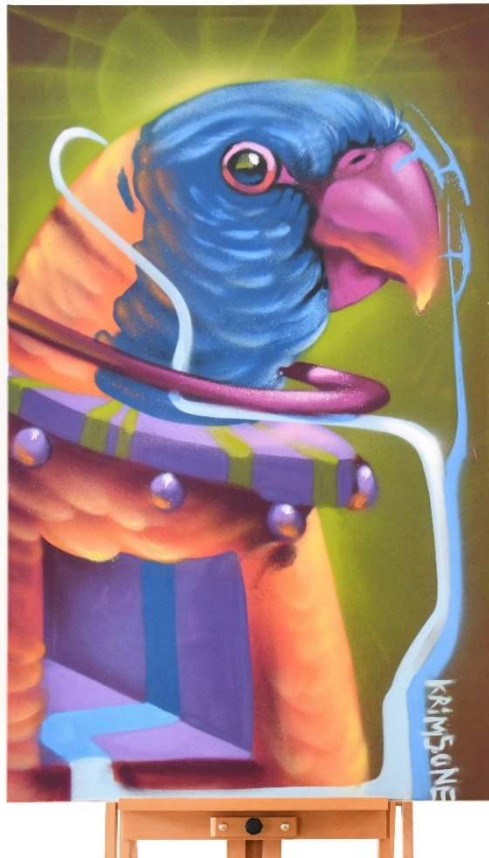

ABOUT THIS ARTWORK

This artwork was painted by **Krimstone** on 8 September 2018 at EATS | BEATS | STREET an event presented by [Kensington Street](#) and [Sydney Fringe Festival](#) celebrating Sydney's established and emerging artistic talent. Artwork size 91cm x 150cm.

Krimstone is a multidisciplinary artist, focusing mainly on aerosol painting. His style resonates around flora and fauna, imaginative style, constructive patterns and colour. He rarely uses a reference and likes to explore ideas from his imagination and turn them into physical marks and colours.

Growing up in the Blue Mountains, Krimstone learnt how to use spray paint from others around him in the graffiti scene and quickly fell in love with the medium. After moving to Sydney he studied at the National Art School in Darlinghurst, where he learnt traditional notions and techniques of fine art. He then graduated with honours, majoring in printmaking, creating a body of work from etchings. Before and throughout his course he painted walls for others and fell in love with the art of mural making.
